Ben Nevis Trek for Kodi

Update—Kodi, a ten year old girl from Killinchy is being treated for a brain tumour in a special clinic near Frankfurt. Her treatment started in June and has been going well. However, over the last two weeks she had a setback due to an infection but is responding well to antibiotics and Professor Hertzog is pleased with her progress. It is hoped that the combined treatment of immunotherapy and chemotherapy along with a regime of radiotherapy will reduce the tumour to such a size whereby it will be possible to remove it by surgery. Please continue to remember Kodi and her family in your prayers.

Preparation for Trek—Mountain training for the trek commenced on 13 July and to date 28 mountains have been climbed and 98 miles walked with almost 26,000 feet of ascent. In addition an average of 20 miles a week of lower level walking some of which has been around Scrabo. Total miles walked so far is around 250 so as you can see preparations is going really well.

Expedition Date—This will probably be in week commencing 24 Sept 4ember or 1 October—we are waiting and hoping for a settled spell of dry weather.
