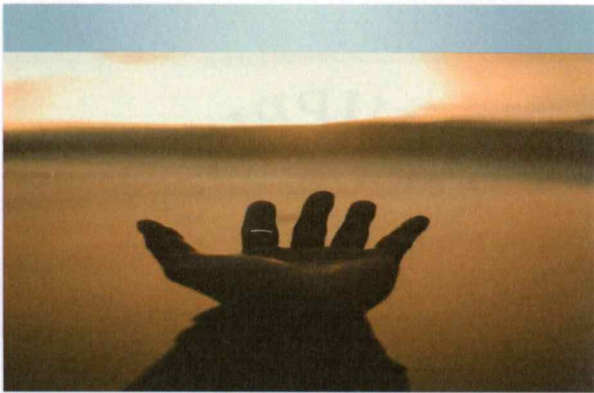

Background

In 2018 Equipping for Life (Efl) began an education support initiative in the Greater Shankill, initially making contact with those already involved in church and community work, along with school principals. Support with reading commenced in 4 local primary schools during the winter and spring of 2018-19, and we are now working with more than 23 primary schools across NI.

Efl is both thankful and privileged to have Archbishop Robin Eames, Sir Nigel Hamilton, Rev Jim Rea and Rev Ruth Patterson as its Patrons.

Mission: to equip people for a better future.

Vision: lives transformed and communities revitalised.

Values: faith based; hope; integrity; equality; volunteer based one-to-one support.

Prayer

Prayer is the foundation of the work of Equipping for Life. Each reading session opens with a short prayer of blessing with each of the children. It is humbling to see the large number of committed volunteers who give so generously of their time to pray for the work we do.

Reading with Children

A child's ability to read is the cornerstone of a successful and rewarding life and our volunteers are passionately committed to helping primary-aged children to improve this vital life skill. The children our volunteers work with come from P2 to P7 and the volunteers are encouraged to use a flexible approach to each session. In consultation with the schools the volunteers may use other resources such as mini whiteboard or educational games to help build self confidence and communication skills.

Tennis Programme

Equipping for Life began to offer free tennis coaching into schools in the Shankill area in June 2021, beginning in Forth River Primary School. Using professional coaches, we provide a basic but fun tennis course to all ages in the primary schools using sponge balls and shortened racquets.

Efl volunteers start the sessions by praying for the children followed by 30 to 40 minutes of coaching. At the end 8 to 10 week of the programme each child receives a certificate. Over the last two years we have coached hundreds of children in seven of the Shankill schools.

Inspire Programme

Inspire, Equipping for Life's most recent innovative programme, established in September 2022, has the vision of inspiring the children of the Shankill to unlock their enormous potential and help shape their future working lives. For the 2022/23 programme we have involved over 850 children with our inaugural events at Wheatfield Primary School followed by Forth River and Glenwood. Our hope is that a seed will be planted in the lives of these young children, the next generation on the Shankill Road, and that these seeds will come to fruition as the children progress in life to achieve their full potential.

Like Efl's other programmes, volunteers are central to the work of Inspire and we are grateful to the growing group of volunteers (Inspire Facilitators), from a wide range of careers, who introduce the jobs they do to the children and their routes to achieving success.
