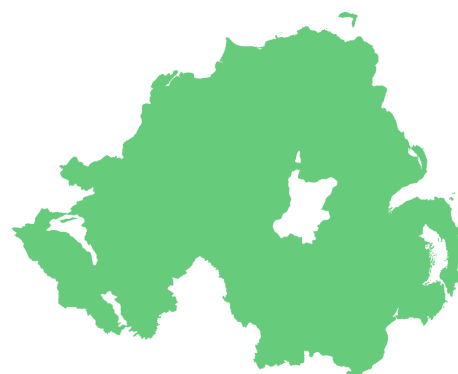

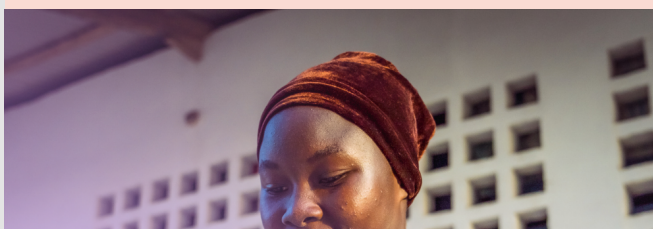

**El Salvador**

This month, Bible-a-Month takes us to El Salvador, where Gen Z are in great need of the Bible.

Gen Z individuals in El Salvador are presented with an enormous task: they are expected to be instrumental in their country's social development and reduction of poverty rates, which currently rank among the highest per capita in Latin America. Gen Z are considered to be those born from 2000-2012. In response to this situation, the Bible Society has developed a curriculum of 32 lessons grounded in personal development with a

biblical foundation, primarily encompassing the New Testament and Proverbs. They are implementing this in public schools across El Salvador, with weekly visits from a team of volunteer facilitators.

**Your Bible-a-Month donation this month will help provide Scriptures and materials to run these classes each week.**

Armed with a Bible-based curriculum of 32 principles, it stands as a beacon of opportunity for engagement with the Gen Z generation. Teaching them these principles from a young age will help them to build a steady foundation on which they can then work on this immense task of transforming the El Salvadorian society.

## Pause and Pray:

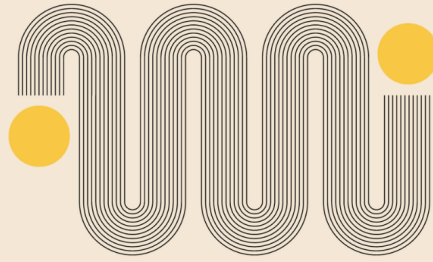
- Pray for the teenagers engaged with this project. May they discover God's purpose for their lives and find clarity, direction, and fulfilment as they navigate their individual paths.
