As we step into another new month, we're reminded of the invitation in Psalm 149 to join together in praise and "Sing to the Lord a new song."

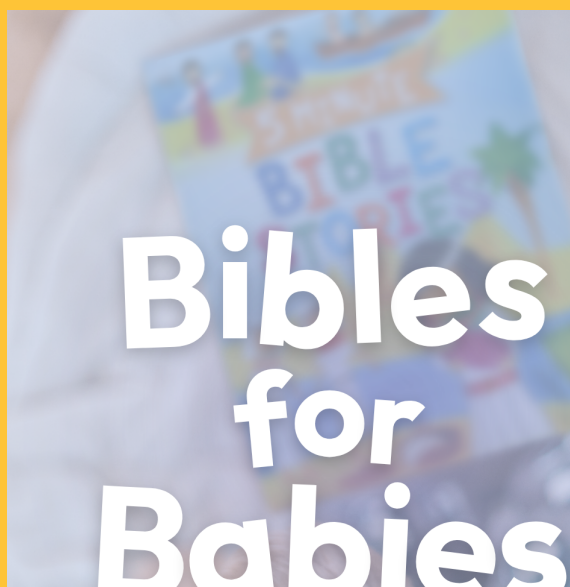

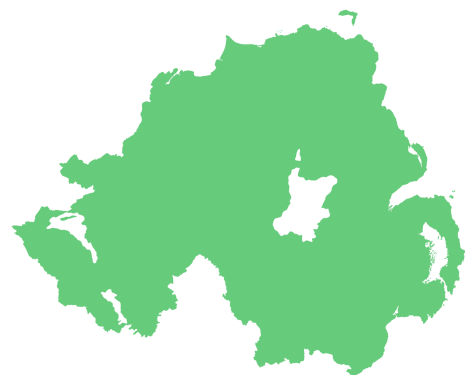

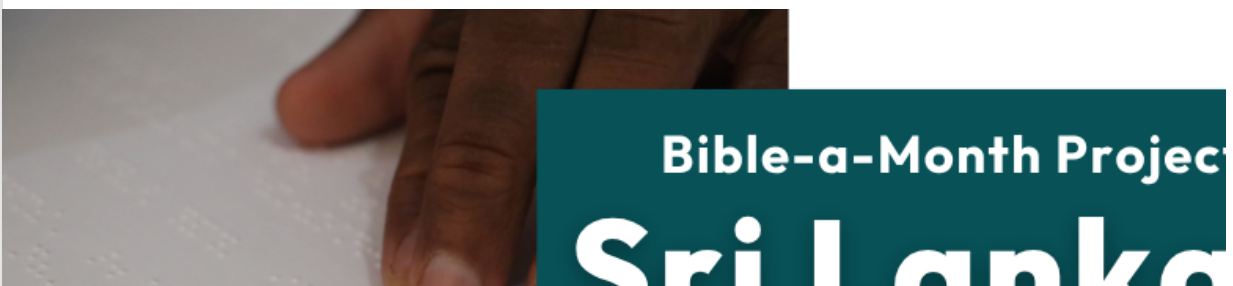

Bible-a-Month Partnership

There's something truly powerful about opening God's Word regularly - allowing His promises to shape, encourage, and guide us throughout the year. Our Bible-a-Month Partnership invites you to make this a reality for thousands of people around the world by becoming a partner. This month, our Bible-a-Month Partnership takes us to Sri Lanka, in South Asia, where the Bible Society is working to supply Bibles to marginalised communities.


Ministry to people with visual impairments and disabilities has always been close to the hearts of those at the Ceylon Bible Society, which is why the Bible Society are working to produce the Bible in braille and audio formats.

Once complete, the team will distribute the books to schools for the blind, homes and churches. Due to the large size of the braille Bibles, the team are finding that most visually impaired individuals are requesting audio Bibles instead, meaning they can listen to it anywhere.

Unfortunately, the current audio recordings are of an old translation of the Bible, which is inaccurate, and is also incomplete which makes it hard for the individuals to fully understand the message of the Bible. This has led to the Bible Society working on new audio recordings of an up-to-date, more accurate translation of the full Bible, which will benefit the visually impaired people greatly.

Your Bible-a-Month donation this month will help to fund the production and distribution of braille Bibles and audio Bibles across Sri Lanka.
