The Dohnavur Fellowship PRAYER GUIDE 2026

Pray with thanksgiving and faith because, 'The one who calls you is faithful and he will do it.'

1 Thess.5:24

Day 1 That God will fulfil His ongoing purposes for us, and show us His will for the future. That we may continue to provide a home for children in need and vulnerable young women and rightly take care for our retired workers.

Day 2 For health and strength in advancing years for the leaders. For wisdom and discernment to lead the Fellowship and introduce changes. That they may carry out their responsibilities in the power of the Holy Spirit. That He will guide them and the Managing Committee Members in decision making about the future and developing the gifts of future leaders and staff.

Day 3 For the Housemothers' relationships with their children, that they may be positive in approach, encouraging each one to develop fully; to be impartial and just, teaching by example. For sensitivity to the Holy Spirit in leading the children to the Saviour, as these children have parents and come from different faith backgrounds.

Day 4 For Trainees in hospitals, colleges and on courses etc., that they will aim high. For discernment to know good from evil when faced with new situations. To keep their hearts pure, choose friends wisely and pray about their future.

Day 5 For those working in our Offices: for all staff in contact with government officials, lawyers, trades people, employees, banks, schools and training places etc. For accounts staff.

Day 6 That the children will grow up feeling secure and loved. That they will value truth and integrity. That their childhood faith will develop and grow into a living, mature faith. For the health and strength for the Housemothers, Wardens, the Superintendent, the Counsellor and all the others who are involved.

Day 7 For the General Body Members to have an increasing awareness of their role as they support the Leaders and fulfil their responsibilities. For dependability, spiritual growth and maturity, learning to lead by example.

Day 8 That we may uphold the legacy and heritage of DF and Amma through our lifestyle, music, poetry, eco-care, spirituality, so that the people are impacted and the vision and mission continue in newly evolving methods staying firm on the roots and principles.

Day 9 For the girls to recognise that their future lies in their attitude to study today. To respect and obey staff; to seek truth and make use of the opportunities given to them while sharing the Good news. For the DF staff and elderly to lead by example to bring their children into His fold.

Day 10 That all Hospital Staff may be ready to do any work and maintain high standards, putting patients first. For wisdom and love for our doctors, dentists, nurses, pharmacists, lab technicians. For physical healing and spiritual blessing for the Patients.

Day 11 That younger staff with potential will respond to the challenge to take on more responsibility, becoming reliable and trustworthy. That the Lord will guide the Leaders to those He has chosen for future leadership roles. That Old Boys and Girls will hear and respond to God's Call to serve here.

Day 12 For our young people and their parents that through the relationship with DF they come to Christ as Saviour and Lord

Day 13 For crop planning, pest control and employee supervision in the fields and gardens; for the Dairy Farm; for a healthy herd and good milk yield. For blessing on the initiatives in organic farming, natural farming, climate resilient smart rain-fed farming, local farmers' meetings and Webinars conducted by DF.

Day 14 For Santhosha Vidhyalaya School and for the President Prince Josiah and the Principal Mrs Lydia Devasahayam, for the Correspondent Jeremiah Rajanesan. For experienced, well-qualified, long-term teachers; for hostel wardens who will give loving, all-round care. That the children will grow spiritually and develop strength of character. For their missionary parents in dangerous, lonely situations.

Day 15 For outreach opportunities through the hospital, teaching in the villages, preaching in local churches, holding gospel meetings etc.

Day 16 For guidance in placing our young women in jobs. That they may work through difficulties and be reliable. For care as they work alongside male staff. To keep close to the Lord, and for guidance and discernment in arranging marriages. Give thanks for the happily married. Pray for newly-weds adjusting; for couples with family and/or money problems, unhappy or broken marriages; those widowed.

Day 17 For our retired sisters contributing in many ways to family life. For the frail and old, living at home or in our hospital; for patience and thoughtfulness for their helpers. For those living in the Vistara and for the enhanced facilities to improve their overall well-being.

Day 18 For our brothers, responsible for government office liaison, legal matters, employees, agriculture etc. For their ministry in the House of Prayer, Gospel Hall, surrounding towns and villages etc.

Day 19 That the teachers in all the schools our children attend may make lessons interesting and the children may develop a keenness to learn.

Day 20 For responsible stewardship of natural resources like water, soil and energy consumption as we are one thousand strong in the campus. Water management, soil care and bio-waste management are critical for the overall well-being of children, staff, elderly and patients who come to the hospital.

Day 21 That in our Spiritual Life we will grow in love for God and His Word, in unity and love for one another. That our lives will be honouring to the Lord.

Day 22 For good relationships with employees and contract workers in workshops, farms and fields, building sites and hospital. For wisdom in dealing with disputes and demands.

Day 23 For the ever-growing number of visitors to DF: day visitors, groups who conduct retreats, for alumni and guests who stay in the guest homes; that they may be blessed by their time in DF. For health and strength for all involved in helping them.

Day 24 Give thanks for Old Boys and Girls working and witnessing in India and overseas. For good relations with their DF home. Pray for those far from the Lord; for a few trying to cause trouble for the DF. For our legal advisors, auditors and well-wishers in various government positions including a few politicians who help us in need.

Day 25 For all working in the kitchens and sewing room; for those helping in the children's cottages; with garden work, housework, etc. and all the hidden, loving service of each person.

Day 26 For protection – whilst travelling; from robbery, moral danger, drug-traffickers etc. From floods, poisonous snakes etc. From accidents in the home, kitchens and in the fields.

Day 27 Give thanks for the ongoing demand for DF books in English and Tamil. That God will provide good translators to meet the demand in non-English speaking countries. Pray for all who write about the Fellowship.

Day 28 For this our 125th year since Amy Carmichael started the Dohnavur Fellowship, that we can introduce new prayer partners to the DF through the different events planned in India, UK and other countries.

Day 29 Blessing and Guidance for the Engineering Department responsible for building maintenance and renovation, purchase of materials, vehicle maintenance, bio-gas plant, power and water supply etc. and new infrastructure development projects.

Day 30 Pray for our UK Administrator, David Price, and DF Corporation Members and Directors; for our Honorary Secretaries in Australia, Canada, Germany, New Zealand, Switzerland and USA. For our Prayer Friends worldwide.

Day 31 India: for integrity in government. That malpractice in the child adoption 'market' may be addressed. That all communities may be valued and freedom of religion respected. For all suffering injustice and persecution. Pray for South India, especially the Tamil Nadu government, that the support to Christian NGOs (Non-Governmental Organisations) may continue.
