Men's Breakfast

Our next Men's Breakfast will be on Saturday 23rd May in Regent St Methodist Scrabo Room. The Special Speaker is Mr William Sayers from Donemana. As a child, William Sayers dreamed of one day taking over the family farm, but that dream vanished in the blink of an eye. On Easter Monday 1990, when he was just 12 years old, he was involved in a farming accident on the home farm in Donemana that almost cost him his life and resulted in the loss of his right arm. The accident ended his and his family's expectation that he would be the fifth generation to take over the land. Since leaving school, William has been employed in sales with the Massey Ferguson dealership, D and M Farm Services Ltd, based in Eglinton, County Londonderry. He also volunteers as a safety ambassador with the Farm Safety Foundation, speaking to farmers' groups, young farmers, and church groups to help prevent avoidable farm accidents. William is married to Elaine for 17 years, and has three daughters—Lydia (16), Grace (13), and Bethany (11). He reflects on how the accident reshaped his life and aspirations, and how his personal faith in the Lord Jesus transformed tragedy into an experience of mercy. "My faith has carried me through," he says. "I consider myself blessed, because not everyone is given a second chance." William is an amazing person and has a very convincing story to tell and will also sing.

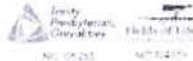

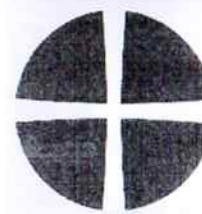


Christian Aid
