PRAYER POINTS

UK: Praise God that since the launch of our *Tech that Protects* campaign in June 2025, over 3,000 support emails have been sent, calling more than 550 MPs to protect children online. Pray for continued favour as IJM engages with MPs, ministers, and Home Office officials, and as legislative work progresses. Pray many more would join this movement for change and [call their MP to act](#).

Germany: Pray for child protection to move from principle to practice in Germany. Following a UN Special Rapporteur's visit, there is growing recognition that tech companies are not doing enough to protect children online. Pray for stronger accountability, meaningful reform, and real protection so perpetrators are stopped and cycles of harm are broken.

Romania: Praise God for February's convening of Romanian officials and child protection experts in Bucharest. Discussions focused on reforming Article 374 of the Criminal Code to clearly recognise online sexual abuse as harm done to real children. Pray the proposed changes pass, so these crimes are treated direct harm towards children, therefore deterring the abuse.

Australia: Prayerfully ask the Lord to move tech companies to use existing tools to detect and prevent online child sexual abuse. Despite clear warnings, many still fail to act. Praise God for IJM's online safety forum at Australia's Parliament House, calling for a Digital Duty of Care. Pray ongoing dialogue leads to decisive action to protect children.

Netherlands: Praise God for the release of IJM Netherlands' *Streaming Hell* documentary, highlighting the reality of online exploitation and the determination of justice leaders seeking accountability. Pray that everyone who watches, including government officials, will be moved to take action and advocate for legislative change.

Thank you for standing with us in prayer, as this global movement continues to grow – bringing children to safety and calling for protection and justice to be upheld.
