📖 **Pray for the Instilling Hope Belfast gathering on 16th June** and for the new library at the PF Centre, that both would provide opportunities for people to encounter God, grow in faith, and find renewed purpose.

Prayer Focus June 2026

Prisons - Male

Pray for D. who has been released from prison and has been worried he will fall into his old ways. He has been coming to bible studies for the last few months in Maghaberry and wants to keep connected to God on release. Pray for the right support for him.

Pray for A. who was suicidal but thankfully we got a chance to talk to him. He said after we prayed that he felt a peace and asked for a bible. He has now started bible studies and hopes to grow closer to God.

Pray for A. who has been struggling with alcohol and drugs from the death of his 4 year old daughter. Pray for God's comfort and peace for him and his partner and for their new baby boy.

Volunteers and General

Give thanks for a number of new volunteers joining us both in the prison and in aftercare work. We appreciate all that they bring to the ministry and pray they would be encouraged as they serve God.

The PFNI Volunteers BBQ in the first week of June celebrates the work and commitment of all those who give of their time and talents to PF's ministry. May God bless this special event.

Remember those who are presently praying about getting involved in the ministry. We are greatly encouraged as they come forward with a genuine willingness to serve wherever there is a need.

Prisons - Female

Please pray for O. who is struggling with her mental health and coming to terms with the length of the sentence she has been given. Pray that she would be able to get the right help and support in custody.

Please pray for M. who is extremely nervous about being released. Pray she would get the support needed on the outside to stay away from alcohol.

Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. Jeremiah 29:12

Please pray for M. who has just been returned to custody and is struggling to come to terms with this. In particular, please pray concerning ongoing issues she is facing with anxiety.

Family Support

Pray for those families who are navigating the stress of having more than one family member in prison at the same time and sometimes having to make visits to two different prisons.

Pray for comfort and strength for J's family who are heartbroken following him being taken into custody.

Give thanks that C. has returned to counselling. Pray that she will be able to stay the course and do what is asked of her to achieve the best possible outcome.

Aftercare - Female

Instilling Hope Belfast group meets on Tues 16th June. Pray for a great morning together for the women and that hearts would be touched.

Pray for a woman who has moved to a new home after months of emotional torture and abuse. God has answered our prayers. Continue to pray for peace, freedom, and comfort.

J. committed her life to Jesus. This is an incredible answer to prayer! Pray for her, that she would stay strong and grow in faith.

Aftercare - Male

Please pray for our new volunteer Mark. He is coming to Lifesplan each week and helping out with the Bible teaching along with Jim, Randy and Ricky.

Please keep praying for S. He is finding it hard to go to church. Don't give up on him. Please keep praying that he will get the courage to go this month.

The new library is now open for men and women at the PF Centre. Please pray for released prisoners to enjoy the special space created for reading and praying.
