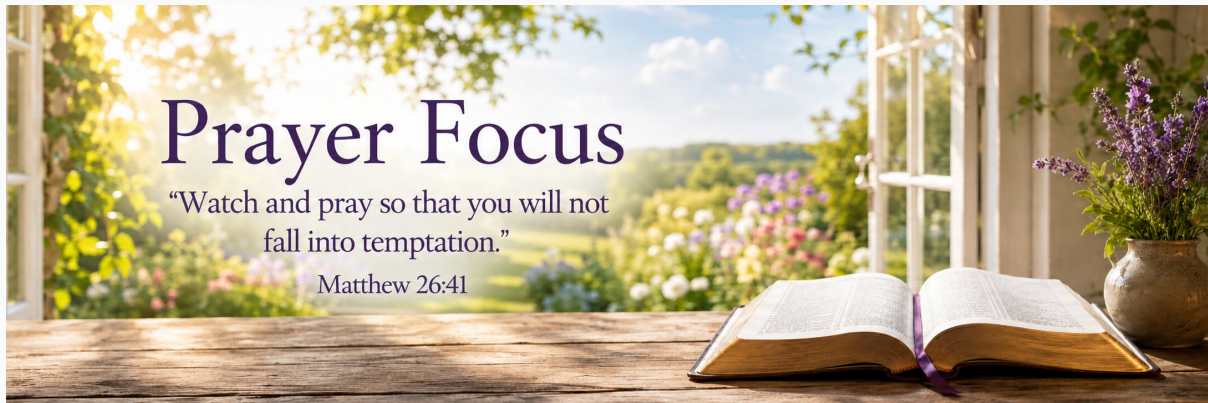

## Prayer Focus August 2026

### Prisons - Female

Please pray for L. who has recently come back into custody. Pray that she will be able to get the right support as she is very upset about being back.

Please pray for W. who has recently received some very unexpected and difficult news. Pray that she would be able to get the help and support she needs to navigate this difficult time.

### Family Support

Pray for folks as they try to reconnect with church and for those seeking to attend for the first time and grow in their love and knowledge of Jesus.

Pray for families who need to engage with counselling services and other support agencies but who lack the resolve to do so.

Pray for mum M. who is concerned for the welfare of her son when released. Pray for the right accommodation and for the right support for her son.

### Aftercare - Female

Pray for Lynne and female aftercare volunteers Joy, Maggi and Jules as they meet during August to plan for a Christianity Explored course starting in mid-September.

Pray for N. who struggles with alcohol and has lapsed a little lately. Pray she will have the strength to make good decisions and for protection.

D. is collecting Bibles (and is preparing them beautifully) for women released from prison. Give thanks for this and pray she will feel encouraged as she blesses others. Pray too for the women who will receive them.

### Aftercare - Male

Pray for T. He has been recalled to prison and is waiting on reports about how long he will need to spend there. Pray for our Prison Workers as they visit him.

Pray for S. He is struggling with serious addictions and has isolated himself from his close family and friends. We are worried what the future holds for him.

Give thanks for all the men and volunteers of The Crew work programme. They have been working very hard during the summer. Pray they get the jobs finished well and get time to celebrate what God is doing in their lives.

### Prisons - Male

Pray for S. who recently attempted suicide in his cell. Thank the Lord that he was found by staff before it was too late. Pray that God would bring him through this difficult period and for his family.

Pray for the football programme which is running in Hydebank for the young men throughout August. Pray for the guys who attend it and for the volunteers who will help to facilitate it.

Pray for a man in Magilligan who has four children who have been taken into care. He would love to rebuild those relationships again.

### Volunteers and General

This month, we will host our annual PFNI BBQ to celebrate the work and commitment of all our North West volunteers. Pray that God would bless this time of fellowship.

Give thanks for volunteers who regularly conduct our Lifesplan meetings in prison. Pray that God would speak into the hearts of those attending and also be an encouragement to the volunteers.

As we look forward to the start of Christianity Explored in September, we need volunteers who would be willing to cook a meal for the women each week, before the session begins.
