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Thank you deeply for your faithful generosity to our brothers and sisters in the persecuted church. Sometimes persecution creeps up on you slowly. Sometimes it happens suddenly - as it did for Jinyi*.

Jinyi's house church was worshipping together when Chinese police burst in and started arresting people. "Everything fell apart quickly," she says. Her husband, Zhang*, was imprisoned. Her ministry to young people was suddenly under terrible threat.

"I wanted to give up," says Jinyi. "You help me realise that the Lord has not forgotten me."

In countries like China, severe restrictions and oppression mean Christians must meet in illegal house churches. More and more believers are being forced underground and discovery is extremely dangerous. Your support is needed now more than ever.

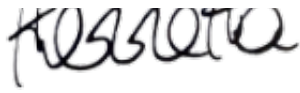
