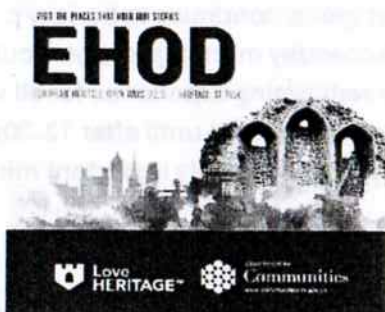

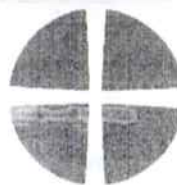
Methodist Historical Society of Ireland Archives
